Penola Catholic College's Instrumental Music Program provides students the opportunity to learn a musical instrument with specialist instrumental tutors. Students receive weekly lessons in a private or group setting in a relaxed and enjoyable environment.

The skills and attitudes gained from learning a musical instrument are beneficial not only for the school years, but for the years beyond the classroom. Research shows that learning a musical instrument can develop:

- Literacy and numeracy skills
- Problem-solving skills
- Organisational skills

We offer a wide range of instruments to learn including:

- Brass: Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Tuba
- Strings: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass
- Guitar: Electric, Acoustic, Bass
- Piano/Keyboard

INSTRUMENT HIRE


The College has a number of woodwind, brass and string instruments for hire. Instrumental music tutors can also advise and guide parents/guardians in the hire or purchase of musical instruments.

Once students reach the required level of proficiency on their instrument, they are expected to join an ensemble. Playing in an ensemble increases music reading skills, aural awareness and teamwork skills and gives students the opportunity to develop new friendships across different year levels.

Our Music Ensembles complement and support our Instrumental Music Program and it is for this reason that students are expected to join an ensemble (at no additional cost.)

One of our most memorable Performing Arts events is our annual Performing Arts Camp.

- Group Lessons (30 minutes) \$220.00 per term
- VCE Music Performance Individual Lessons (45 minutes) \$280.00 per term
