Digital Literacy

Digital Essentials 1

Tuesday 3hrs p/wk 9.30am - 12.30pm 10 Weeks starting 3/10/23

Do you know how to use you your phone, tablet and computer? Are you curious about the internet, but worried about safety?

This course is designed to help learners understand the basics of various areas of technology, including different digital devices, their functionality and the ways people can use these devices to connect with others and access services over the Internet.

Introduction to Microsoft Word and Excel

Tuesday 2hrs p/wk 1.00pm - 3pm 10 Weeks starting 3/10/23

This course aims to provide learners with the confidence and skills to keep in step with innovation and requirement changes in the workplace. It also aims to give learners the confidence to embrace digital skills.

Introduction to using MS Word for the workplace. Includes using templates, exploring the key features of MS Word, and using tables. Using templates to create a resume and cover letter. Focuses on recycling language from a position description to help get a resume or cover letter through an ATS and attaching documents to emails.

Introduction to using MS Excel in the workplace for simple tasks.

Includes timesheets; sorting and ordering information; using basic SUM formulas; calculating tax; exporting and printing MS Excel sheets.
