Dear Parents and Carers

On behalf of our school, I want to say a big thank you to all our students, parents and carers for your continued resilience and support throughout this time. Parent Teacher Student Partnership Meetings

We have made the decision to shift the next round of Parent Teacher Student Partnership meetings from Thursday July 15 (Week 1) to Thursday August 12 (Week 5) of Term 3. This allows teachers in new subjects for Semester 2 more time to get to know the students and complete some assessment prior to these meetings taking place.

Face masks

Secondary school students aged 12 or older must always wear a face mask at school whilst indoors, including when attending an Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) program, unless an exception applies. Face masks are mandatory for all school students aged 12 or older when travelling to and from school.

To support the health and wellbeing of all students and staff, our school will continue an enhanced cleaning routine and will encourage frequent handwashing.

If your child is ill or is feeling unwell, they must not attend school. They must remain home and seek medical advice.

These measures are aimed at giving health authorities the best opportunity to stop the spread of the virus in our community.
