Dear Parents,

I am writing to remind you of the arrangements for Year 11 and 12 students on Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> September.

There will be no Year 12 classes running on this day as <u>all</u> Year 12 students are involved in the General Achievement Test (GAT). Year 11 students studying a Units 3 & 4 VCE or scored VET will be required to sit the GAT.

Year 11 students who are not required to sit the GAT will have a remote learning day where their work will be placed on MyPenola.

For the first time all Year 12 VCAL students will be required to sit the GAT. All Victorian senior secondary students (Year 12) will this year have their literacy and numeracy skills measured against new standards in a redeveloped GAT.

The new standards will indicate whether students have demonstrated the literacy and numeracy skills typically expected of someone completing their secondary schooling – giving another indication of their readiness to move onto further education, training, or employment. VCE and Senior VCAL students who are enrolled in one or more VCE or scored VCE VET Unit 3-4 sequence are required to sit both Section A and B. This includes students who are enrolled in the VCE or a scored VCE VET Unit 3-4 sequence who are not planning to undertake their scored assessments.
