Lesson Type

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Lessons are held weekly during class time and rotated so students do not miss the same subject each week.

Piano/Keyboard lessons are only available as individual lessons. All other instrumental lessons are available as either Individual or Group Lessons.

VCE Music Performance lessons are for students studying VCE Music Performance (Units 1 – 4).

Students must notify their instrumental tutor with at least 24 hours notice to cancel a lesson (without penalty).

The decision to study an instrument is a full year commitment. If continuation of lessons is no longer possible, parents/guardians can complete a *Notice to Discontinue Instrumental Music Lessons Form* (available upon request.) Cancellations will take effect from the beginning of the subsequent term. Students discontinuing lessons are still required to continue with their music ensemble for the full year.

N.B. - Students of families who have arrears with their school fees are not permitted to participate in optional programs without College approval.
